



#### HLSA Speaker-Message from Kuldeep Singh Chib


Hello everyone,

I am Kuldeep Singh Chib currently working as Senior Field Service Manager in HLS Asia Limited. Let me share my life in brief:

"Life is a roller coaster. It has its ups and downs but it's your choice to scream or enjoy the ride."

My life is also full of many ups and downs...struggle teaches you a lot of things. It's been quite a roller coaster ride but I have grown and learned a lot about myself.

I was born in a village at Line of control in district Jammu. My grandfather migrated to this place in 1947 due to tensions in the region. The fore fathers of our family had mostly served in Indian Army. My grandfather served in Azad Hind Fauz. My father served in Indian Army. I saw the army personal life from very close during my childhood. It was very exciting to move from one place to other with the transfer of my father. Due to this, I strongly developed the desire to join Army. Such was the desire that I applied for Indian Navy job once I met the minimum age criteria. I went through all the exams and finally got the call letter to join. At that time I was in class 12th and once my teachers came to know about this, they did not let me leave studies and join Navy. They encouraged me to join it after completing 12th by NDA exam. I tried through this exam but could not qualify SSB interview. In parallel, I tried for MBBS/Engineering entrance exam and worked hard to qualify MBBS but got qualified for Engineering.



Got admission in Mechanical Engineering stream at NIT Srinagar in 2001, it is one of my sweetest memories.... I completed my engineering while enjoying the beauty of Kashmir. The campus is situated on the bank of Dal Lake, one of the most beautiful ambience, the lake, western Himalayan Mountains, chinaar trees and yes Snow fall. Due to militancy, campus placement at NIT Srinagar was negligible those days. So I was always having concern of getting job after completing degree. HLSA was one of companies which had hired few of our seniors during that time, so I had the idea about work profile. Luckily during our time, some companies started coming and I got selected in Hindustan Zinc Limited (Vedanta Company). Afterwards HLSA also came for campus but I was not allowed as I was already selected before.

Joined HZL in 2005, worked in this company for 10 months, had a very good experience going to underground Zinc and Lead mines at different places in Rajasthan. Also got experience of working in Zinc and Lead processing plants at Chittoregarh. Finally there was off campus placement drive from HLSA and I applied and went through written and 3 rounds of interview and finally got selected.





I joined HLSA on 15th May-2006. I took the first flight of my life from New Delhi to Dibrugarh and joined at Duliajan office. Amidst the natural beauty of Assam, I started learning logging. I found it very exciting during those days as we use to travel long distances daily through beautiful Tea Gardens and do the job at well site and came back in evening. During Initial period I worked in Duliajan, Nazira and Agartala.

Afterwards got a chance to move to Gandhinagar, it was altogether different place as compared to North East. I remember one incident where we were moving to rig site and the approach road was fully flooded with water. There were fields on both sides of the road and if we continued moving there was chance of KWT0010H getting off road and stuck in field. The crew was determined to move to the rig and 2 of them got down and moved on flooded road to guide the logging unit to rig site. This is one of the good old memories which we still cherish.

Afterwards moved to Northeast again for mobilization of new project at Jairampur, Arunachal Pradesh. Unfortunately that project got cancelled and I moved to Agartala. It was another great challenging experience. Professionally it was a tough location but very beautiful place to explore.

In Jan-2012, I got a chance to move to Halliburton, joined at Malaysia. It was a new start up location for Halliburton. It provided a good foundation to learn Halliburton procedures and work methods as everything was set up from beginning. Also it was my first time working in offshore rigs. The one thing which I did not like working there was non availability of Indian food. I used to eat bread with butter most of the time.

Then in 2014, I moved to Abu Dhabi, very hot and humid environment. Enjoyed working in these adverse conditions. The experience of driving Land Cruiser in desert is exciting and joy forever. Moved to Norway in Sep-2019, worked there till Dec 2019 and left Halliburton. Norway is the best place for Oil field worker as it provides proper balance between professional and personal life. Joined HLSA again in Jan 2020 and enjoying my second innings.

Personal front I have 1 younger brother and 2 sisters. All 3 of them are happily married. Brother initially worked in HLSA and currently working in Baker. Father got retired from Indian Army in 2004 and happily living post retirement life. Mother is housewife. Got Married to Ashu (My classmate during 11th & 12th at Kendriya Vidhyalaya) in 2008. Have two children, Pari and Yuvraj.




